Teams and Clubs can sign up to run the snack bar during ACES games. All money earned goes directly back to the club/team working the game.

Serving alcohol is <u>required</u> to work at the concession stands, 2-3 adults are required to have their bar card per game. To obtain a bar card, click <u>here</u> to complete the <u>Alcohol Awareness</u> <u>Training</u> online and take the test in person. There is a \$15 fee but if you need help paying it, let the Boosters know.

How does my team/club earn money from working Aces games?

There are several *months* in the Aces season. In each *month* there are several games.

For every game your team/club works, you **receive one share**. If you work two games, you receive *two shares*. Three games, *three shares*. And so on.

For each month the money from all the games is added up and **divided by the number of shares** in that month. Then each share is paid the same amount. For example, if there are four games worked in a month, four shares exist, and the total money is divided equally into four parts. If you worked two of those games, you have two shares and you receive half (two out of four) of the money.

Common Questions:

What if the Aces split my group into multiple booths at a game?

It's unlikely, but the Aces might split your group into multiple booths. Your team/club will still receive *one share* for that game. The Aces will send payment for the 2nd booth worked, that money will be added to the payment for the overall month and will be divided equally among the shares paid.

What if the Aces assign me a booth that makes less money?

The more games that are worked, the more money is made, even if you might have a slower booth for one game. By dividing the monthly check equally among all shares, it helps to balance out busier vs. slower booths. **Overall, the more you show up, the more you can earn.**

When will my group be paid?

As soon as the Aces send Boosters the check for a month the shares are calculated, the money is divided, and checks are written to your accounts. Checks from the Aces are *typically* received between 2-6 weeks after the end of the month, then Boosters *typically* provide checks to Wooster Bookkeeper within 1-3 working days of receipt.
